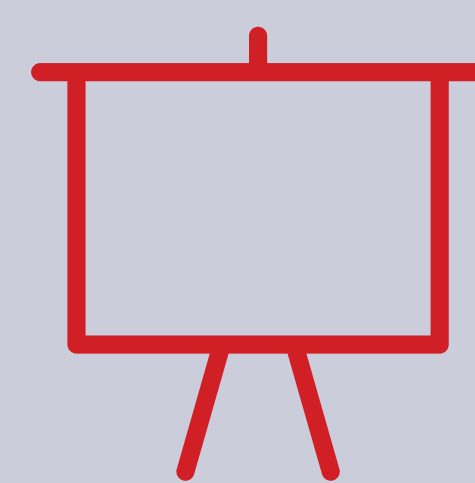

## ABOUT DH-IGNITE

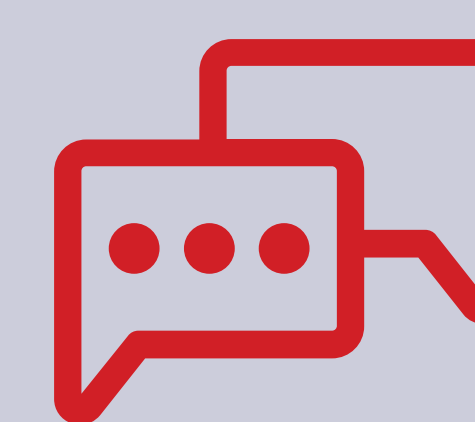

#### **Interactive sessions**

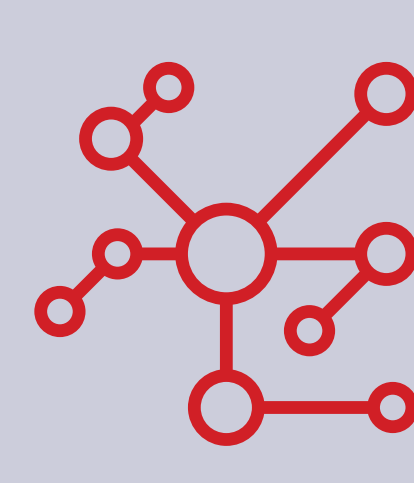
Interactive discussion sessions that will inspire the use of computational tools.



#### **Posters and booths**

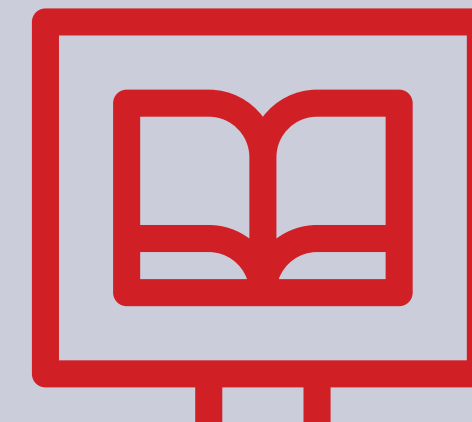
Showcasing of work done or proposed in DH and CSS by colleagues in humanities & social sciences.

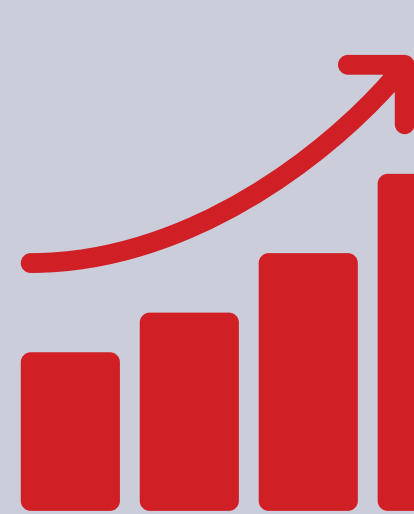
#### **Connect**
